

SENIOR INTERNSHIP PROGRAM ORAL MAXILLOFACIAL SURGERY

The Department of Oral Maxillofacial Surgery has instituted a Senior Internship Certificate Program to those eligible candidates, who are genuinely interested in improving their skills in minor oral surgical procedures.

AIM

To improve the understanding and practical skills of the candidate in minor oral surgical procedures.

OBJECTIVES:

- To disseminate the principles of minor oral surgical procedures.
- To give hands-on experience in minor oral surgical procedures.

OUTCOME:

- To increase the number of undergraduates practicing general dentistry to perform minor surgical procedures with confidence.
- To make undergraduates more competent in minor oral surgical procedures.
- Can identify the complication that occurs intraoperatively and postoperatively in minor oral surgical procedures.
- Become capable enough to manage the various complications that occur during minor oral surgical procedures.
- Can recognize the common medical emergencies that occur in a dental clinic setup.
- Become knowledgeable about emergency drugs and get trained to use equipment's like oxygen cylinder, mask and pulse oximeter.
- Can efficiently do primary management for patients having medical emergencies in a dental clinic.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Completion of BDS from a university recognized by the Dental Council of India and registered with the DCI.
- Should have completed Compulsory Rotary internship programme of 12 months in the institution where graduation was completed.
- Preference for candidate with higher marks in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery if more than two candidates apply.

DURATION:

- Hundred days (Application will be accepted twice a year)

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- The senior internship certificate programme will commence on FIRST week of MARCH and SEPTEMBER of every year.
- The programme will last for a period of hundred days and the candidates will be posted in the department of Oral Maxillofacial Surgery. (Total 2 sessions/Year)
- All candidates should follow the department protocol (dress code and patient protocols)

FEE STRUCTURE:

A fee of Rs.25,000/- will be charged for the entire program of 100 days.

The fee has to be remitted by DD in favor of Principal VMSDC to the college account in whole payment within 3 days of applying for the senior internship certificate programme.

Amount once remitted will not be refunded at any cost.

NOTE:

- The students should bring their own instruments.
- The student should be present from 9AM to 3PM in clinics during the whole program.
- **A minimum of 80% attendance is mandatory for this programme.**
- Any damage to department property/equipment shall warrant replacement.
- At the end of the program, a certificate will be given for its successful completion which will be signed by the head of the department and principal.

CURRICULUM:

(i) Orientation lectures on:

1. Operating room protocols
2. Sterilization and disinfection
3. Local Anesthesia
4. Exodontia
5. Impaction
6. Medical emergencies

1. Extraction of firm tooth.
